

Very easy slouch beanie

This is a beanie that slouches, not a tam nor a beret. I wanted a longer beanie, but one that slouched, and couldn't find one to suit my own needs so created the pattern.

J hook

H hook

1 skein of yarn of your choice. I use red heart super saver, because it is economical, but you can use your own favorite yarn. The stitches used are hdc, dc and sc.

Sorry no gauge on this. If you want a looser slouch either go past row 18 or try a bigger hook.

Row 1 Make 10 hdc with a magic circle. Click [here](#) for instructions. Sl St, ch 1

Row 2 2 hdc in each stitch around. Sl st, ch 1 (20 hdc)

Row 3 1 hdc in next stitch, 2 hdc in next stitch, all the way around. Sl st, ch 2 (30 hdc)

Row 4 1 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next stitch, all the way around. Sl st, ch 2 (40 dc)

Row 5 1 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next stitch, 2 dc in next stitch, all the way around. Sl st, ch 2 (50 dc)

Now depending on how big you need this (i.e. head size), you may want to inc 1 or 2 rounds, but keep in mind you want this to be a beanie not a tam or beret. The hat will fit tight.

Row 6-18 1 dc around (50 dc)

Row 19-20 change to hook H and sc around.
